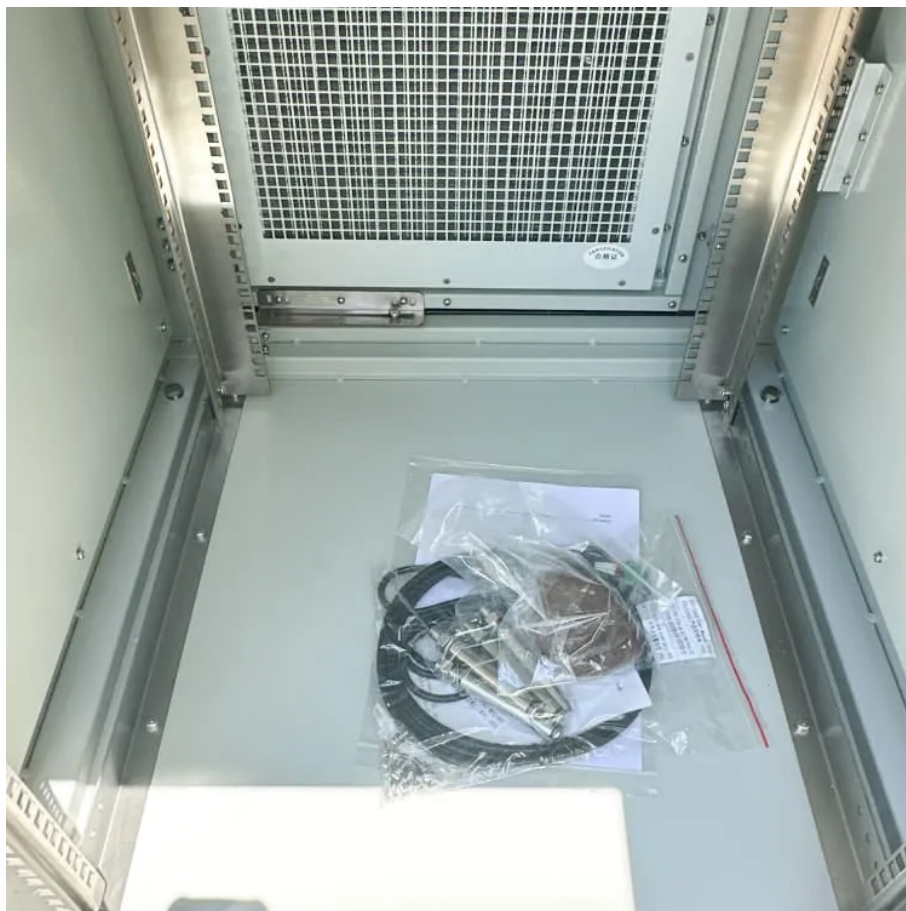

Overview

* Do not replace the battery of your SimpliSafe base station with a non-rechargeable battery; this may cause the battery to corrode, therefore damaging the cells.

Popular for its affordability and low-cost monthly monitoring subscription, SimpliSafe has been at the forefront of home security over the last few years.

SimpliSafe's base station is unique in that although it can still be connected to a power outlet, in the event of power failure, it can switch to its in-built rechargeable battery to keep the system running. According to SimpliSafe, the rechargeable battery can power.

Like most battery-powered things, SimpliSafe devices require a periodic replacement of their batteries. When a device needs its batteries replaced, you will notice an error.

The Base Station takes four (4) 1.2V, 1300mAh nickel-metal hydride (NiMH) rechargeable batteries. Regular alkaline batteries should never be inserted into the Base Station, as they may damage the device. Once you have acquired the necessary NiMH rechargeable batteries, you can follow the steps below to replace them:.

NEVER insert regular alkaline batteries into the Base Station as they may damage the device. Plug your Base Station back into power. Was this helpful?

What happens if a battery dies in a SimpliSafe accessory?

When the batteries die in any of your SimpliSafe accessories, all you have to do is replace them. The exception is only found in the Base Station that uses rechargeable AA batteries; you can recharge the batteries and reinsert them. SimpliSafe has no statement on using rechargeable batteries in any other accessory.

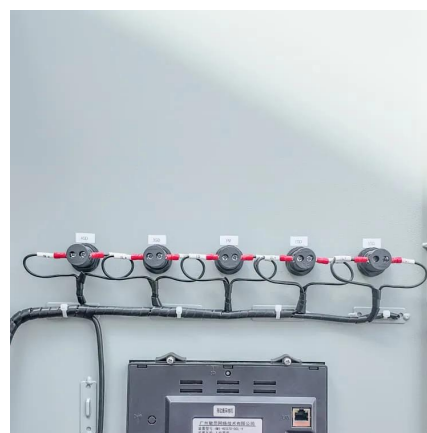

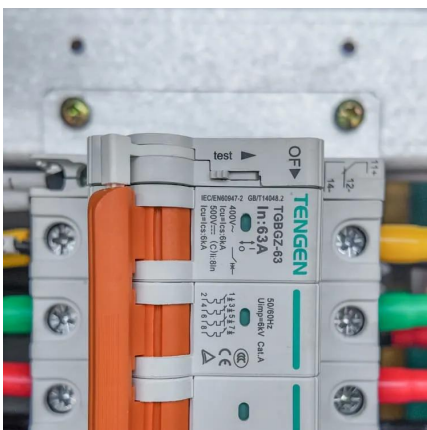

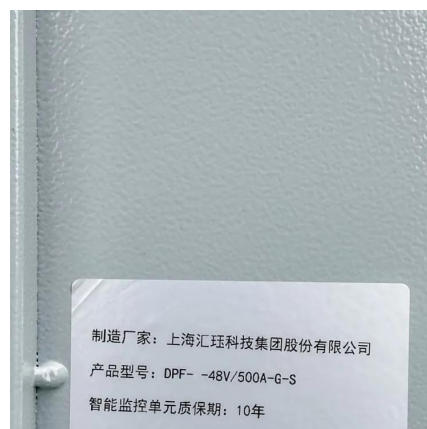
